



## PROGRESSION IN PRINTING

If and when opportunities arise for pupils to experience printing, the progression for printing is as follows:

EYFS	KS1	LKS2
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>To explore print making using different blocks including fingers ,hands, feet, food, Lego, shaped sponges, rollers.</li> <li>Experiment printing with everyday objects including natural and manmade objects (e.g. Sponges, fruit &amp; veg, leaves, lego, fork, buttons, cotton wool).</li> <li>To explore rubbings to show textures and patterns.</li> </ul>	<p>Identify printing in the environment (e.g. wallpaper, fabrics)</p> <p>Demonstrate a range of techniques (e.g. rolling, pressing, stamping and rubbing).</p> <p>Experiment in making different patterns that can be made with the objects (e.g. using different parts of the object, layering the pattern, turning the object).</p> <p>Experiment with how to apply the paint to the object (dip/brush.</p> <p>Build a printed repeating pattern.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Make a printing block by sticking items that stand proud of the block (e.g. string, polystyrene etc.)</li> </ul> <p>Use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding in this strand</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Research printmakers.</li> <li>Explore pattern and shape in creating designs for printing.</li> <li>Organise their work in terms of repetition, symmetry or random printing styles.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Create a printed block with detail for printing with polystyrene.</li> <li>Use a variety of tools to make the marks in the polystyr.</li> <li>Make choices about coloured inks/paints and paper/materials to print on.</li> <li>Design patterns of increasing complexity with precision.</li> <li>Use more than one colour in their designs.</li> <li>Use key vocabulary to demonstrate knowledge and understanding in this strand.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
